



Remote learning in the event of a Bubble Closure or further full lockdown

- EYFS Daily Cheeky Challenge, story time, phonics and number
- Daily English and Maths learning opportunities via Google Classrooms
 - All lessons should have a personalised short video or audio introduction from class teacher or TA
 - This could make use of White Rose Maths, Bitesize or Oak Academy lessons if this is most suitable
 - We will endeavour for lessons to include a variety of active learning
 - A submission will be required for each lesson
 - Feedback will be given via Google Classrooms
 - If work is not being received or verbal feedback would be most suitable to address a misconception a member of staff will telephone the child.
 - Handwriting and spelling practise will also be daily Rockstars will also be daily
 - Lexia as an intervention in Y5\6 and for all pupils in Y3 and Y4 will be part of the days expectations
- Daily further two lesson/activities
 - Topic related
 - All subjects should be included
 - Physical challenges included
 - PHSE
- Daily Google Meet or Zoom Collective Worship session 15 minutes
 - Monday – values
 - Tuesday – Bible Story linked to value
 - Wednesday – Story linked to PHSE outcome
 - Thursday – Inspirational person or event
 - Friday – Stars of the week and a fun activity for the weekend
- Intervention groups
 - 1:1 children will have daily video contact with a TA unless in school
 - TA's or Teachers may deliver some small group intervention if appropriate or individual (please note that if small group work occurs no child's abilities should be exposed to other families within the group- take care with what children are being asked to do)
- Individual contact with children
 - Once a week individual 'Tutor time' to discuss work from the week this should be six children a day for 10 mins each
 - Class e-mail addresses to be 'manned'
 - School telephone will also be 'manned' so that if phonecalls are needed for families they can get in contact.
- Individuals isolating
 - Teachers will ensure that there is work on the Google Classrooms and will make phone contact with parents
- Staffing
 - All adults working in school are classed as 'key workers'
 - All staff to be available to work and in school unless ill or isolating
 - Social distancing and precautions will be maintained in school
 - Staff can deliver the remote learning from their classrooms and have the support of colleagues around if needed
 - Phone calls can be made from school
 - Staff do not require another member of staff on Google meet or zoom calls but should have another member of staff nearby
 - PPA to stay on the same day as usual for that pod
 - Staff meeting to remain on a Wednesday after school via zoom
- Key worker group
 - Will be arranged into the three bubbles – KS1 and Rec, Y3/4 and Y5/6
 - All of those staff not linked to a class will be linked with Key Worker provision
 - We will try to keep the same staff with the same bubble throughout
