

Term 1 Curriculum Newsletter – Let's Listen to a Story

On the first day of term, the children will be starting the topic with a **Wow Day!** They will be looking for story clues, retelling stories and being creative!

In Maths, we'll be...

- ...reading and writing numbers to 20.
- ...learning about place value to 20.
- ...beginning to add and subtract numbers to 20.

In English, we'll be...

- ...reading Little Red Riding Hood, acting it out then writing our own versions.
- ...reading the legend of Robin Hood then creating our own legend and making it into a book.

In Science, we'll be...

- ...labelling the different parts of animals.
- ...learning about the five main animal groups.
- ...classifying animals in the five main groups.

In Art we'll be...

- ...learning about the artist Henry Matisse and creating a collage inspired by The Snail.
- ...illustrating our own story.

In Design Technology, we'll be...

- ...designing and making our own front cover.

In Geography, we'll be...

- ...making a map of the journey to Grandma's house and use compass points to describe the route.
- ...using map symbols and a key.

In History, we'll be...

- ...comparing how stories were told in the past with the present.

In Religious Education, we'll be

- ...about the religion Judaism.

In Computing we'll be...

- ...learning about tempo, rhythm and patterns.
- ...creating digital music.

In PSHE, we'll be...

- ...thinking about friendships and family.

In P.E we'll be...

- ...practising different ball skills.
- ...balancing and moving in different ways.

In Music, we'll be...

- ...using our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and
- ...listening to music and creating music patterns.
