In Maths, we'll be...

- ...learning to count money.
- ...learning to compare and calculate with money.

In Geography, we'll be...

- ...looking at human and physical features of the school grounds and local area.
- ...looking at aerial photographs and plans to recognise landmarks.
- ...making a map showing human and physical features to a key.

In History, we'll be...

- ...learning about the Great Fire of London and comparing events of the past with the modern day.
- ...learning about how houses have changed over time.

In Computing we'll be...

- ...learning the concept of labelling and grouping objects based on their properties.
- ...creating pictograms to show information.

In PSHE, we'll be...

- ...discussing the different groups we belong to and the people we have in our community.
- ...learning about money and how to use it in a sensible way.

In P.E we'll be...

- ...learning about fitness.
- ...developing our gymnastics skills.
- ...learning how to aim at a target.
