

TOPIC: Out of Africa

Science

In Science, we will learn about the 7 processes that living things carry out. We will investigate the adaptation and classification of a variety of creatures.

Scientific investigations will be used to explore the requirements for plant growth with consideration given to planning fair tests, as well as recording and analysing results.



Geography

We will be using maps, of various scales, to find out about the continents, as well as different locations in Africa and around the world. We will learn about the different biomes found on the African continent. We will apply this as we learn about animal and human migration out of Africa over time and enforced migration through the slave trade.

French

The focus of our French lessons will be describing the weather.

PE

In Netball, children will be developing their understanding of the attacking and defending principles of invasion games. In our Team Building lessons children will work individually, collaboratively in pairs and groups to solve problems and will be encouraged to be inclusive of others, share ideas to create strategies and plans to produce the best solution to a challenge.

Computing

Children will be learning how to create images using google drawings including vector drawing and 3D modelling.

RE

Children will reflect on how to use respect during RE lessons and in the wider community. We will think about our own worldviews and what shapes these. We will then focus on Christianity by looking at how Christians describe God through biblical texts and how they believe God is both holy and loving.

Music

In Music, the children will be learning to perform the song Make You Feel My Love by Bob Dylan. They will sing the song as well as learning to play different classroom instruments.

Art

Our classes will create artwork inspired by Africa, African artefacts and African animals; the projects will encompass a variety of media, skills and techniques.

History

The focus of our History lessons will be the slave trade between Africa, England and America.

PHSE

In PHSE, our work will be based around relationships and our school's 5 GREAT actions. We will think about the effect(s) that our behaviour has on others.
